March 4 – 8 and Looking Ahead to March 11 – 22

PLEASE BE ALERT! Traffic control is in place for your safety.

Activities During the Week of March 4 – 8: What's Being Accomplished?

- Tree and brush removal: complete on eastbound (toward Salinas) and has begun on westbound (toward Monterey) side of Imjin Parkway
 - Installing perimeter silt fence on project construction limits on eastbound and westbound side of Imjin Parkway
 - City repairing potholes on Imjin Parkway
 - Partial median removals at Abrams Drive and Imjin Road.

Upcoming Activity: What's Happening in the Next 2 Weeks (March 11-March 22)?

- Complete tree & brush removal—complete removals on westbound side of Imjin Parkway and shift to westbound side. Traffic control will shift lanes to facilitate equipment working from the roadway.
 - Complete installation of silt fence at project limits.
 - Temporary markings for construction zone striping.
 - **Imjin Parkway night closure 8:00 P – 6:00 A Monday through Thursday beginning 3/18 thru 4/2 for striping and concrete barrier installation to shift traffic to eastbound roadway.**
 - **Construction zone speed limit signs will be posted – 25 mph speed limit – enforceable!!!**

- Once night work is complete for the striping and installation of concrete barrier, construction will begin on walls at Preston Avenue and Abrams Drive.
