Construction Activities Update: November 24 – December 5, 2025

PLEASE BE ALERT!

Pay attention to the delineators marking the edge of the traveled lane.

Not all pavement areas are open to traffic.

Recommended speed through roundabouts (during construction) is 15 MPH

The enforceable speed limit through the construction zone is 25 MPH

TIPS FOR DRIVING ROUNDABOUTS:

- **VEHICLES ALREADY IN THE ROUNDABOUT HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY**
- **VEHICLES MERGING INTO THE ROUNDABOUT:**
 - **CHECK FOR PEDESTRIANS CROSSING IN THE AREA**
 - **YIELD TO VEHICLES IN THE ROUNDABOUT AND MERGE SAFELY**

What's Happening in the Next 2 Weeks (November 24 – December 5)

Day Shift

- Continue planting landscape materials (native plants and trees).
- Continue working on list items to achieve project completion.
- Place remaining concrete in median areas on Abrams Drive (south).
- Continue layout for permanent pavement striping and markings.

Night Shift

No night shift work is anticipated

Activities That Took Place Last Week (November 17 – November 21)

- Continued planting landscape materials (native plants and trees).
- Continued layout for permanent striping and markings.

Future Construction Activity and Information: What's Planned in the Future?

- **Phase 4: Final permanent pavement striping and markings!** Temperatures have been too cold/wet at night so we are shifting our operations to the day shift. Currently we are anticipating permanent striping operations mid-December. We are all working together to shift schedules and crews to get this final roadway activity completed so that we can open the full roadway section as soon as possible. WE APPRECIATE YOUR PATIENCE and hope the weather cooperates!
- **Artwork installation at roundabouts.** We are working with the contractor and his vendor to finalize the final details of the artwork. Anticipated delivery/installation is anticipated in February/March of 2026.
